

Cornhill London Week

History

Cornhill London Week has been running since the middle of the 1960's. It is a conference designed for people considering gospel ministry to come and see first-hand what it might look like. One of the unique elements of London Week is classroom teaching coupled with placement in a local church, alongside a ministry family.

Why do we run it?

The greatest need the world has is to hear the good news of Jesus Christ. For this to happen there is an urgent need for men and women to be equipped, enthused and encouraged to herald that message. Cornhill London Week, we hope will be used as a stepping stone to see many hear that call and spend their lives as preachers and teachers of God's Word to the glory of God.

Who is if for?

Cornhill London Week is for anyone exploring whether full-time gospel ministry is for them. Historically it has been for students in the final or penultimate year of university, but in recent years we have tried to open it up to anyone for whom it might be useful.

Where does it happen?

Cornhill London Week takes place in central London at Willcox House on Borough High Street near London Bridge station. It is here that delegates will receive talks and lectures on gospel ministry, as well as sitting in on some teaching at the Cornhill Training Course. Each student is also placed with a ministry family in London where they have opportunity to be involved in the life of the church and see what ministry looks like first-hand.

How much does it cost?

The cost is £90 which includes all your teaching and accommodation.

When does it run?

Cornhill London Week starts at 10:30 on Thursday 13th December (delegates may be able to stay in London on Wednesday 12th December).

The Conference finishes at 13:30 on Monday 17th December.
